

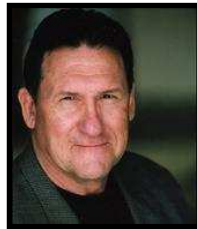
TEAM HOLLYWOOD

MELINDA CLARKE- #24 Melinda starred as the materialistic and conniving Julie Cooper in the hit Fox series, "The O.C.", she can also be seen this summer on the hit HBO series, "Entourage." Melinda has spent a career playing out of the norm characters including the mysterious and intelligent Dominatrix on "CSI-Crime Scene Investigation" and has gained cult status around the world for such roles as Jessica Priest in "Spawn" and Velasca on "Zena: Warrior Princess", both of which earned her trading cards and action figures.



MAURICE GREENE- # 32 Maurice Greene holds several world records and Olympic medals earned during his years as a star in Track and Field. In 1999 he set the 100 m world record at 9.79 s (+0.1 m/s wind), beating Donovan Bailey's standing world record of 9.84 s (+0.7 m/s wind), and lowering the world record by the largest margin since the advent of electronic timing. Recently Maurice hung up his track shoes for dancing shoes and proved he had all the right moves on "Dancing With The Stars", finishing 5th overall.

MICHAEL JOHNS- #10 Singer / songwriter Michael Johns became known to millions after his electrifying performances made him a favorite with "American Idol" fans around the world. A top-ten finalist during the show's 7th season, singer-songwriter Michael Johns is releasing his debut album *Hold Back My Heart* this summer. Michael has helped in the fight against Lou Gehrig's disease by donating the proceeds from the recording of his holiday song "Another Christmas".



ART LAFLEUR- #9 Art LaFleur has appeared in numerous feature films throughout his career. A former University of Kentucky football player, Art established himself in Hollywood by playing roles in a number of iconic baseball films including "The Sandlot" and "Field of Dreams". Among his many other feature appearances are "The Replacements" with Keanu Reeves, "Air America" with Mel Gibson, and playing an unusual Tooth Fairy in "The Santa Clause" films with Tim Allen. Art has supported The Strike Out Lou Gehrig's Disease tournament since its inception.

KATE LINDER- #16 Kate Linder began portraying Esther Valentine on CBS' "The Young and the Restless," the #1 rated soap opera, over 27 years ago. On April 10, 2008, Kate was honored by receiving a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. She has served as the celebrity spokesperson for The ALS Association for 4 years since her brother-in-law's diagnosis





JESSICA MENDOZA- #2 (Manager) Jessica Mendoza has become a mega-star and international leader in women's softball. Jessica has appeared in two Olympics (2008 & 2004), winning a gold medal in '04. Other accolades include USA Softball Female Athlete of the Year, two-time World Cup Champion, and while playing for Stanford was First Team All-American from 1999 – 2002. In a pre-Olympic tour for the 2008 games, Jessica hit .495 with 21 homers, 107 RBI and 51 extra base hits in 59 games. She and her husband are currently expecting their first child.

NANCY O'DELL- #4 Named as one of Television Week's 10 Most Bankable Stars in Syndication, Nancy O'Dell serves as the co-anchor of "Access Hollywood", the daily entertainment newsmagazine currently in its 13th season. Among numerous other assignments, Nancy has been a co-host for NBC's network coverage of the Tournament of Roses Parade since 2000. An award-winning journalist, O'Dell has been honored with three Associated Press Awards, two Society of Professional Journalists (SPJ) Awards, and is a seven-time Emmy Award nominee.



DANNY PINO- #22 Danny Pino is a versatile actor who has enjoyed success on the big and small screen, as well as on stage. He recently wrapped production on the thriller "Across The Hall," for Universal and will next be seen in "The Burning Plain," an ensemble drama that features Charlize Theron and Kim Basinger. He is about to begin shooting his 7th season this summer as Detective Scotty Valens on Warner Brothers' hit series "Cold Case." Danny has portrayed a wide array of characters ranging from the drug-lord sociopath on the acclaimed series "The Shield," to the iconic Desi Arnaz in the bio-pic "Lucy".

RICHARD ROUNDTREE- # 80 During his illustrious career, Richard has appeared in over 70 feature films. First blasting onto the scene to become an international superstar when he portrayed the character of John Shaft in three films, Richard moved on to work extensively in both film and television.
